

CAPAX DEI = CAPABLE OF RECEIVING GOD

Capax Dei: The word of God in today's readings tells us that the Spirit is at work in us, individuals and communities filled with himself. The Spirit makes us capable of receiving God.

With this new capability for God, the Holy Spirit guides us into the way of Jesus which is all the truth (Jn 16:13). By that way he renews the face of the earth (Ps 103:30), and he gives us his fruits (Gal 5:22-23).

The Apostles were paralyzed with fear, shut in the Upper Room to avoid the aftermath of Good Friday. Now filled with the Holy Spirit, they would no longer be ashamed to be Christ's disciples; they would no longer tremble before the courts of men. They would now understand fully the way of Jesus, the way of the cross which is all the truth. For them now the death of Jesus was not his defeat, but rather the ultimate expression of God's love, the way that banishes selfishness for one's own gain, pursuit of personal interests, the way of Jesus who goes out of himself, who serves us to his last drop of blood.

This way of Jesus, all the truth, became Good News to be proclaimed to all, to which we are witnesses.

By this way, the Holy Spirit renews the earth. (Ps 103:30) If we allow ourselves to be renewed by the Spirit, meaning to be re-formed by the Father on the model of Christ, we will indeed be able to experience the freedom of the sons and daughters, in harmony with all creation. The garden in which we live is not entrusted to us to be exploited, but rather to be cultivated and tended with respect (cf. *Gen* 2:15). Only in this way, we will be able to see reflected in every



creature the glory of the Creator, as the Psalm 8:2.10 says: "How great is your name, O Lord our God, through all the earth!" He renews...

In the Letter to the Galatians 5:22, Saint Paul shows the "fruits" manifested in the lives of those who walk in the way of the Spirit. They are those who by faith allow the Spirit of God to break into their lives. In them, God's gifts "fruits of the Spirit" blossom: "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control." This is the programme for life: "Walk by the Spirit." (Gal 5:6, 25)

The world needs men and women who are not closed in on themselves, but filled with the Holy Spirit, capable of receiving the way of Christ, and eager to sow the seeds of the Holy Spirit. With courage and patient perseverance to the work of the Holy Spirit, we are sure that the face of the earth, which is the face of our families, of our Parish, will be renewed.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

FIRST READING Acts 2:1-11 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages.

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because all heard them speaking in their own languages. Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own language? Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and converts, Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power."

SECOND READING Romans 8:8-17 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh; you are in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit that dwells in you. So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh—for if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ— if, in fact, we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.

On the faithful who are true and profess their faith in you, in your sev'nfold gift descend! Give us virtue's sure reward, give us your salvation, Lord, give us joys that never end!

COMMUNION ANTIPHON Acts 2:4,11: They were filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke of the marvels of God, alleluia.


