



How to live the Gospel this weekend.

This weekend we are invited into thinking about what resurrection looks like. This is a very complex topic to explore so I will defer to our Archbishop. Mark, who will give us an insight into what this looks like for us today. "Some say that it would not matter if we found the bones of Jesus, the Resurrection would still have meaning. But for the Church, it would make a world of difference. A merely spiritual resurrection would be no resurrection at all. The Resurrection of Jesus gathers up the entire human person: body, heart, mind and soul. For if that were not true, then death would still have its victory at some point in human life. But the resurrection of Jesus means that death has no more victory- not at any point of human life, nor even in the cosmos, since the Easter proclamation has summoned the whole of creation to join in our rejoicing." Archbishop Mark, 'Words from the Wound, p. 274.

TASK: How do we celebrate this great gift of resurrection in our own lives? And what are our daily resurrections which we need each day to be a better Christian?
