



The roof

In summary, guttering and down pipes have been replaced; new rain heads have been installed. Glass in / around the spire has been replaced and resealed with construction-based water sealant.

Last Tuesday the faulty structure of the 'spire" was discussed with the project team.

A way forward was robustly debated and a new structural solution was determined.

To ensure the waterproof integrity of the As Parish Priest, one mass on the "curtain" (made of construction-based **| 7am.** material) installed around the spire. New flashings (top, sides and bottom) will ensure that all water is carried onto the roof not under the roof.


The scaffold will be removed before Christmas: reconstruction activities will commence on 6th January 2020.

How to live the Gospel out this weekend

In the eighth century BCE (Before the Common Era) Jerusalem which was a part of Judah was led by King Ahaz. King Ahaz lived in a time of great war. Assyria (modern day Iraq) was the superpower in the region. Assyria was at war with both Syria and Israel. King Ahaz was worried that his Kingdom was not able to defend themselves against Assyria if he aligned with Syria and Israel. So, since he was an astute leader, chose to side with Assyria, so that at least his kingdom would not be obliterated. Enter the Prophet Isaiah. What advice does Isaiah give to King Ahaz. He says, 'don't join with Assyria. Trust in God and everything will work out.' How do you think King Ahaz is going to respond to that? He thinks it's a crazy idea. So the prophet Isaiah then says to Ahaz, 'if you don't believe me, ask God for a sign.' Ahaz refuses to do this, for if he is shown a sign from God, he will be acting directly against the will of God.

There is a bit of King Ahaz in all of us. Ahaz was afraid to take a risk and to trust God. Ahaz is so determined to follow his own path, he shuts out all dissenting voices, even the voice of God. Ahaz fails to understand one of life's fundamental lessons; every great journey of discovery involves risk and the journey of faith demands surrender and a willingness to make a leap into the unknown.
