### How to live the Gospel out this weekend.

We are now off and running with Matthew's Gospel and we gain a small insight in these next few weeks with the authors of Matthew and what themes they were trying to present to the people. Just remember again from last week, Matthew was written around 70CE, so about seventy years after the resurrection of Jesus. They were Jewish converts who were starting to practice the teachings of Jesus, yet all was not well in the camp. There was a lot of internal fighting and the taking of sides with different leaders at the time.

Have we come a long way from this in 2020?

Matthew's Gospel is big about teaching and after the Sermon on the Mount in Mt 5, we get some real gems about what it is like to deal with our humanity. Such topics include, anger, adultery, revenge, charity, prayer and of course one of the most challenging ones (week 7) 'love of enemies'. This is a great opportunity to look at our humanness in the light of Scripture.

Spend some time with Matthew 5 and 6 and pray to God for the strength to overcomes any weaknesses you may have in these areas listed above.
