Moving towards a July 18 start



There is much to do in order to get the church ready for a July 18 return. If you have been out, you will know that entering into any public premise now has conditions to it. In all restaurants and clubs there is a sign in process. This is just to ensure that if someone is sick, people can be contacted in relation to this.

Here is the official statement by the state government:

Venues are required to have "COVID-safe" plans in place, and in the majority of cases, these have been submitted by the sector's peak body.

In announcing the changes, Chief Health Officer Dr Jeannette Young reminded people all of the same rules around keeping a 1.5metre personal distance, washing hands regularly, and staying home if you are sick, apply.

Importantly, Dr Young said venues were also responsible for keeping the contact details of anyone who attended their premises, should it be needed for contact tracing in the event of an outbreak.

"I know it's onerous, but we are asking people to keep that documentation for eight weeks," she said.

If we can keep this in mind, all will go well. I also want to remind people that at this stage we will only be offering one mass on a weekend which is physical. The 9am mass will still be live streamed for some time. This is so that people who are comfortable with staying at home, stay at home. It is not a race to get you all back to Church. If you feel comfortable, then come, yet there is no pressure to stay at home.
