Financial summary for June 2020

Dear Parishioners,

As a part of being transparent, accountable and with good communication, I have asked the finance council to give a report on the state of our income since lockdown. I'm not pushing anyone, yet it is important to let you know how we are going at this time. We pray for all the Brisbane churches who have been asked to lock down at this time. Fr Marty

During the period January to March 2020, the average parishioner contribution was \$13,387 per month. It should be noted that during the Covid-19 restrictions, the average parishioner contributions for the period of April to end June was only \$5,528 per month. Total contribution for the six month period was only \$56,776.

To meet Holy Family Parish operating / running costs a contribution budget for this six month period was set at \$84,300. This means that Covid-19 restrictions contributed to a reduction of parishioner contributions of \$27,524 in 3 months.

Other sources of parish income (outside school care and refunds) during this period have assisted in meeting our Holy Family Parish financial requirements.

From a financial perspective, during the same six month period, the cost of operating / running the parish (expenses) has continued at the pre Covid-19 level of \$15,605 per month (total \$93,633 – which excludes church and house maintenance).

Previously mentioned (in past Holy Family Parish weekly news letters), parishioner contribution methods have changed around Australia. Holy Family Parish will not continue with weekly contribution envelopes from mid 2021. There are a number of contribution methods that are available to parishioners, including direct debit and bank payments. If you need help to set up this recurring banking facility, please contact Audrey Ho in the Parish office for support and help.
