How to live the Gospel out this weekend.

Jesus speaks of himself being lifted up, which connotes being exalted by God as well as being lifted up on the cross – one leads to the other. And when he speaks of 'everyone who believes' he is not talking of believing doctrines. He means the kind of trust and reliance that characterises those who commit themselves to Jesus. This secure confidence expresses itself in living according to his values.

We see in these lines of John that Jesus is pure gift to humanity and the early Christian language of relationship describes the mission of Jesus as the result of God sending his Son to save the world. In his letter to the Romans (5:9) Paul writes that we will be saved from the wrath of God through Jesus, but certainly in John's gospel, in which Jesus focuses on the love of God, there is nothing from Jesus about the wrath of God. The point made in today's reading is that humans are free to choose between the way of goodness and the selfish way of refusing to follow the agenda of Jesus. God will not condemn evildoers, they will choose their own destiny and alienate themselves from Goodness. (Laurie Woods, 2021)


