
Use of the app will help the Queensland Health contact tracing team quickly identify and assist anyone who may have been exposed to COVID-19.

# How to Live the Gospel out this weekend





This section ends with the ascension scene that may well have been adapted from Matthew or Luke, but that is not of great significance. What is important to note here is that the ascension marks the end of Christ's activity and signals the handover, as it were, to the disciples. The ball is now in their court to carry the gospel to others. There is no doubt they will do it because they have personally encountered the Lord Jesus. It is the intimate relationship with Jesus that gives life to our belief and commitment. Second- hand witness counts for a lot, but personal encounter and engagement with Jesus promotes genuine knowledge and assurance. Meeting Christ in the Scriptures, rubbing shoulders with him in the person of another human being, feeling his touch in the kindness of a helping hand or an encouraging word are all ways by which we can deepen our relationship with him.
