HELLO! From Fr Marty

I have always been fascinated by the power of the mustard seed

Not having seen a tree the size of the one mentioned in the Gospel, it intrigues - because it comes from such a small seed.

Our faith, in many ways is like the mustard seed.

It is small and hard to understand, yet in times of joy and doubt, it can be quite impressive to us.

Faith is unseen, yet it can be quite powerful within us at certain times.

Our faith is what sustains us in all kinds of situations.

Yet it needs to be nourished.

Coming to Eucharist is also another thing that is experienced, vet cannot be seen. It is based on faith.

Nourishment from Eucharist will increase our faith in ways we cannot even begin to understand.

However, we are transformed in this process.

When we receive the body and blood of Jesus today, ask God to transform us in ways that will rival the impressiveness of the mustard seed, so that we will be able to walk in the ways of God, with faith, hope and love.
