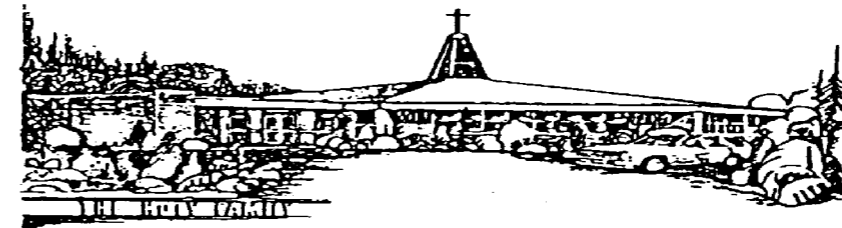

Safeguarding & Workplace Health and Safety Audits

Next week, the following audits will be carried out in Runaway Bay Parish :

Safeguarding on Monday 10th October 2022 at 10.30am
WPHS on Thursday 13th October 2022 at 10.00am. The audit will commence after the Fire Safety Training.

The Archdiocese has adopted the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards and was audited against the Standards in late 2019. During 2020, work has been undertaken to bring Archdiocesan safeguarding practices in line with the Standards, including auditing processes.

Our parish has been selected, with others, to participate in this internal safeguarding audit this year. A small, medium and large parish from each Deanery has been selected for an audit. The audit will be conducted by the safeguarding team.

The purpose of the audit is to develop a plan to assist our parish to move towards compliance with the new requirements of the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards. We expect the audit will take approximately 2 hours.
