PROFILE

Monsignor Peter Joseph Meneely VG

Vicar General – Archdiocese of Brisbane

Monsignor Peter Meneely is a priest of the Catholic Archdiocese of Brisbane. He was born in Warwick in 1959 and grew up in the Toowoomba Diocese in the cities of Warwick and Toowoomba. He was educated at St Mary's Convent School Warwick, St Josephs Colleges in Warwick and Toowoomba, completing his high school education at Downlands College Toowoomba. He began studies for the priesthood at Pius XII Seminary Brisbane on the 7th of February 1982. He was ordained a deacon on the 3rd of June 1988 and then ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Brisbane on the 10th of February 1989. He has served in the parishes of St Kieran's Brighton as a Deacon, Stella Maris Maroochydore as an Associate Pastor and St Bernard's Upper Mt Gravatt as Parish Priest. He was the Administrator of St Luke's Parish Buranda, Brisbane. In March 2000 Archbishop Bathersby appointed him to the position of Moderator of the Curia - Archdiocese of Brisbane.

During the past 34 years, Monsignor Meneely has been primarily involved in parish pastoral ministry and archdiocesan administration. He has also been involved in a variety of archdiocesan projects, initiatives and committees. In 1993 Archbishop Bathersby appointed him to the Pastoral Planning Committee and since then, he has been extensively involved in the pastoral planning processes and projects for the Archdiocese. Monsignor Meneely is a past Chairman of the Commission for Evangelisation and Pastoral Planning and has served as both the Chair and a member for several years on the Clergy Appointments and Transfer Advisory Committee. He was a member of the preparatory commission for the Archdiocesan Synod in 2003. He is also currently the Director of the Overseas Priest's Program for the Archdiocese.

In his role of Moderator of the Curia, Monsignor Meneely had responsibility for oversight of the curial offices of the Archdiocese. On the 1st of June 2003 Archbishop Bathersby appointed Monsignor Meneely as an Episcopal Vicar for Catholic Education, Social Welfare, Financial Administration, and Church Life and Mission with oversight of Brisbane Catholic Education, Centacare Brisbane, the Faith and Life Vicariate and the Archdiocesan Financial Services Vicariate. He has been an ex officio member of the Archdiocesan Finance Council, The Archdiocesan Development Fund Board, the Catholic Education Council, the Centacare Council, and the Archdiocesan Services Council.

With the installation of the new Archbishop in May 2012, Archbishop Coleridge appointed Monsignor Meneely to the office of Vicar General of the Archdiocese on 19 June 2012, a position that incorporates many of his previous responsibilities as Moderator of the Archdiocese. On the 25th of July 2012 the Holy Father Pope Benedict XVI named him a Prelate of Honour with the title Monsignor. He worked within the Francis Rush Centre in the precinct of the Cathedral of St Stephen and at the Brisbane Catholic Education Centre in Dutton Park. As well as his ministry in the archdiocesan Curia Monsignor Meneely was involved in the sacramental ministry through his ministry in St Luke's Parish Buranda and in many other parishes throughout the Archdiocese.. He also assists at the Cathedral of St Stephen.

He is currently the Administrator of Runaway Bay parish.
