Parishioners are advised that the Holy Family Church has an EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE, a FIRE BELL and EXIT POINTS. In the case of an alert, parishioners should remain calm and look for the nearest EXIT sign in GREEN. Everyone should move in an orderly fashion to the FIRE ASSEMBLY AREA outside the Church carpark and along Simbai Street.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLANS are located on the walls throughout the Church. They have been modified due to changes on the school grounds.



 saying, 'How quiet and peaceful it is,' that the worst suddenly happens, as suddenly as labour pains come
 on a pregnant woman; and there will be no way for anybody to evade it.

But it is not as if you live in the dark, my brothers, for that Day to overtake you like a thief. No, you are
 all sons of light and sons of the day: we do not belong to the night or to darkness, so we should not go on
 sleeping, as everyone else does, but stay wide awake and sober.

 a third one; each in proportion to his ability. Then he set out. Now a long time after, the master of those

 that I have made." His master said to him, "Well done, good and faithful servant; you have shown you
 can be faithful in small things, I will trust you with greater; come and join in your master's happiness.'"
